

REGULAR VERBS (PRESENT TENSE)

The verbs in Spanish have two parts, the stem and the ending. The stem tells the verbs meaning. The ending conjugates (changes) to go with a particular subject.

	-ar	-er	-ir
Yo	-o	-o	-o
Tú	-as	-es	-es
Él / Ella	-a	-e	-e
Usted	-a	-e	-e
Nosotros / as	-amos	-emos	-imos
Ustedes	-an	-en	-en
Ellos/as	-an	-en	-en

The following -er and -ir have an irregular yo form.

- Hacer (to do) - **Yo hago**
- Poner (to put) - **Yo pongo**
- Traer (to bring) - **Yo traigo**
- Salir (to go out) - **Yo salgo**
- Ver (to see) - **Yo veo**
- Saber (to know) - **Yo sé**
